Essential tools and supplies: four key items

- Gel plate – purchased** or homemade (Tara recommends 5 x 7 inches)
- Rubber brayer or roller
- Acrylic paint – Tara recommends Golden Open paints
- Photocopy paper (A5/A4 or letter size)

**Please use caution if purchasing a new gel plate: Speedball brand is not suitable for acrylic paint.

Extend your experience with the following items:

Paper:

- Art paper – 225 gsm
- Mixed media paper
- Ikea paper
- Brown paper

Painting supplies:

- Pigments
- Alcohol inks
- Paint pens
- Ink
- Paint brushes

Tools and supplies:

- Masking tape
- Bamboo Baren
- Scissors
- Scalpel or craft knife
- Cutting mat
- Ruler with grid
- Glue stick
- Compass
- Display folder/book
- Sketchbook
- Hand sanitiser or Baby wipes
