Technology:

- Cell /mobile phone or digital camera
- Computer or iPad
- Basic inkjet printer or all-in-one inkjet copier and scanner
- Photo editing program or phone app such as SnapSeed

Materials:

- inkAID (inkjet receptive coatings)
- Acrylic paint
- Various fabric remnants, as well as interfacing/stabilizer
- Various recycled papers, tissue paper, freezer paper
- 4ml plastic sheeting (not vinyl)
- Natural bristle/chip brush
- Scotch tape, sticky tape, and glue stick
- Gel medium, liquid medium
- White and black gesso

Tools:

- Nozzle bottles
- Mark-making tools
- Iron
- Cutting mat, ruler, and either a rotary cutter or scalpel and scissors

This is a speciality product that is applied to surfaces – both porous and non-porous and allows you to print on virtually any surface that can be feed through your inkjet printer.

inkAID Starter Kit (suggestions from Wen)

The most versatile inkAID product is:

- **Clear Gloss Precoat Type II** (1 pint)

As an extension to the Type II coating, you may wish to experiment with these options:

- **Iridescent Pearl Gloss Precoat** (1 pint) – This product is Wen's go-to precoat. It is suitable for both porous and non-porous surfaces. Note: a small sample is included in sets below.
- **White Matte Precoat** (1 pint) – Please note, a similar result can be achieved by painting the surface with white gesso and applying Precoat Type II over the top.

Note: inkAID suggests purchasing pints for the best value and to save on shipping costs.

Sample set boxes (Wen believes sample kits are a great introduction but may be more than you need to get started):

- **Iridescent Inkjet Receptive Coating Sample Set** – Set contains 4 ounces (125ml) each of Iridescent Pearl, Silver, Gold, Blue, Red, Bronze, Ultra Lilac, and Green coatings.
- **Inkjet Receptive Coating Sample Set** – Set contains 4 ounces (125ml) each of White Matte, Clear Semi-Gloss, Clear Matte, Clear Gloss, Clear Gloss Type II, Translucent Gloss, and Iridescent Pearl coatings.
