- Acrylic paints
- Watercolour paints
- Paint brushes
- Inks/ink pad
- Crayons
- Water-soluble crayons
- Pencils
- Graphite sticks
- Eraser

Paper:

- Photocopy paper
- Watercolour or mixed media paper
- Cardstock
- Cardboard
- Baking paper

Miscellaneous:

- Thread
- Scissors
- Camera (phone or other)
- Photo editing software

Printing supplies:

- Gel plate**
- Rubber roller/brayer

Nice-to-have (but not essential):

- Ezy carve rubber block
- Lino tools
- Stamp pad
